Under 18, Boys & Girls East Antrim Open Golf Competition

1. The Trophy shall be called the Under 18 East Antrim Open Golf Competition to be played for annually.
2. The Competition shall be under the control of Cairndhu Golf Club.
3. (a) Age Qualification: Competitors must be Under 18 years of age as of January 1st in the year of the Competition
(b) Handicap Qualification: Only Competitors who hold an Official (G.U.I.) Club Handicap may compete in this event. Maximum handicap allowance: Boys 28, Girls 36
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without stating any reason for so doing and may call for the production of a Birth Certificate of any Competitor before or during the Competition.
5. The Committee reserves the right to limit the number of Entrants who may participate in the Competition and Entries shall be numbered in handicap (lowest) order. Should there be players of equal handicap for the final places, then a ballot shall be the method used to allocate these places.
6. The Competition will be over 18 Holes Stroke Play. In the Case of a Tie the normal R & A recommendations on splitting ties will be applied.
7. The Winner of the Competition will be the Under 18 East Antrim Boys / Girls Amateur Open Winner and will receive a Perpetual Trophy as well as a Prize.
8. He / she will return the trophy to Cairndhu Golf Club one month prior to the date of the following year's Competition and he / she shall be responsible for having his / her name engraved on the Trophy.
9. In the event of a Tie for the Competition or other placings, these shall be decided in accordance with the R & A guidelines for 'Break of Ties'.
10. Prize fund value of **£1000**. Overall winner plus Gross and Nett Prizes for Boys & Girls in the categories of Under 18, Under 16 and Under 14.
11. Entries shall be accepted in writing and on an "Official Entry Form", and the Entry Fee shall be set at £10.00 stg.
12. No Professional Golfer or Person whose age exceeds the age limit for the Competition may act as a Caddie. Penalty: 2-strokes at each Hole up to a maximum of 4-strokes.
13. Conforming Driving Clubs – The driver the Player carries must have a club head, identified by model and loft that is named on the current list of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R & A Rules Limited.
Note: Any individual Driver on the list, if tested on the pendulum apparatus approved by the R & A Rules Ltd., must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds.

14. The Penalty for Breaching Rules 3, 12, & 13 shall be disqualification of the Player(s) concerned.

N.B. – These conditions must be read in accordance with GUI's General Rules
